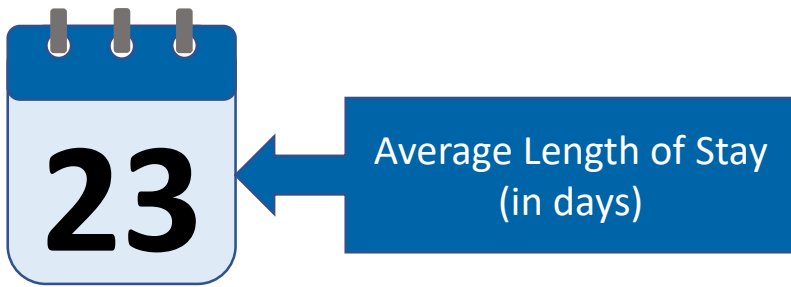
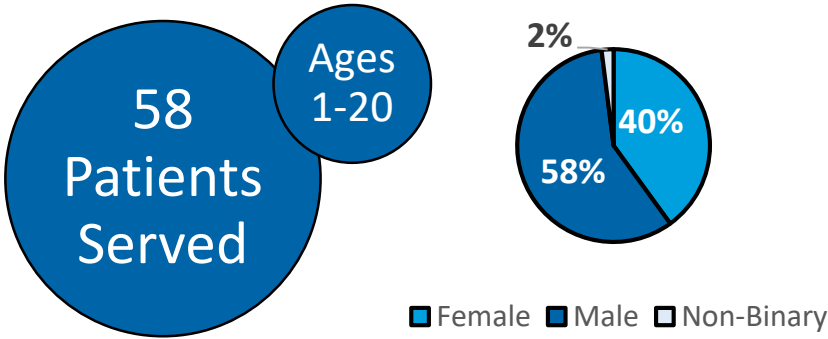
The mission of the Acute Care Rehabilitation Program is to comprehensively support the patient and family while maximizing functional independence.
